


<p>Enquiry 1: How did the Ancient Greeks influence the Western world?</p>	<p>Being a Writer: Theseus and the Minotaur</p>	<p>Enquiry 2: How do we hear sound?</p>
<p>Year 4's next enquiry allows learners to work as historians as we enquire about democracy, architecture, Gods and the Olympics.</p> <p>As we journey through our enquiry, we will be comparing Ancient Greek life to current life.</p> <p>We will answer the enquiry question with a debate at the end of the unit where children will decide which aspect of Ancient Greek life had the biggest impact on th Western world.</p>	<p>Alongside our enquiry, we will be reading the Greek myth Theseus and the Minotaur. This story is all about how Theseus sails to Crete to defeat the King's deadly Minotaur who live in the labyrinth beneath his palace.</p> <p>We will be using this myth as inspiration for diary entries, letters, character descriptions and setting descriptions focusing on the use of expanded noun phrases and fronted adverbials.</p>	<p>After our Greeks enquiry has finished, we will be moving on to our third enquiry of the year 'How do we hear sound?'</p> <p>This enquiry will allow children to work as scientists and investigate the question through scientific experiments.</p>

<p>In Term 2, children will continue with place value, looking at rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100, 1000 and looking at Roman numerals.</p> <p>As we move through the term, we will then focus on the four operations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and explore using all four of these operations in a variety of different problem solving scenarios.</p>	<p>In reading, children will continue to work on their fluency in reading fluency lessons.</p> <p>Children will also be exploring the class book 'Who let the God's out?' in our extended read lessons.</p> 	<p>Children will explore the question:</p> <p>'What do Christians learn from the creation story?'</p> <p>Children will be exploring the creation story. Looking at the story of Adam and Eve and what we can learn from it and exploring the 10 commandments.</p>

<p>In Term 2, children will be looking at audio production. Children will look at all the important features needed to record audio on a device.</p> <p>They will then use these skills to plan and record a podcast in groups about a chosen subject.</p>	<p>Children will develop their 3D skills to produce Greek vases. They will develop their joining skills as well as trial different methods of adding texture as they carve their models with paper mache.</p>	<p>In Term 12, children will be completing dance and hockey units.</p> <p>They will be learning a sequence of dance moves to put into a dance routine, they will then perform these to the class.</p> <p>They will be learning how to hold a hockey stick correctly, control the ball and score a point in a hockey game.</p>
