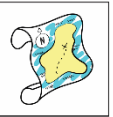

Key Vocabulary	
Country - a nation with its own government.	Location - a particular place or position.
Temperature - the degree or intensity of heat.	Weather - the conditions outside at a particular place and time.
Climate - the general weather conditions in an area.	Region - an area with definable characteristics.
Tropical - happening near the equator.	Temperate - a region with mild temperatures.
Polar - relating to the North or South pole.	Rainforest - a dense forest found in tropical areas with large rainfall.
Global Warming - current rise in the average temperature of Earth's air and oceans.	Tropics - regions that lie in the middle of the globe.
Vegetation - the plant life of a region.	Habitat - a place where living things naturally live and grow.
Topography - the physical features of an area.
