Year 6 Trip to The Life Skills Centre, Monday 10th November and Tuesday 11th November 2025

As part of our Personal and Social Education Program in Year 6, we have arranged a visit to an interactive exhibition in Bristol called 'Lifeskills – Learning for Living'. This teaches children important skills including road safety, fire safety, hazard avoidance plus awareness and how to act in different types of emergency.

6CW will attend on Monday 10th November, 6ER will attend on Tuesday 11th November and 6KP will be split between the two sessions (please check Arbor for which session your child will attend).

The coach will leave school at 9.00am and return to school at approximately 12.30pm (depending on traffic). Your child will need a packed lunch on this day. If your child normally receives a free school meal and you would like us to provide a packed lunch, please email natasha.jefferies@ststephensjuniors.org.uk by Thursday 6th November. No spending money is required and school uniform should be worn as usual.

The breakdown of cost is £9.00 for the entrance to Lifeskills and £6.40 for the coach travel. This is a voluntary contribution of £15.40, available to pay through Arbor and the deadline for payment to be made is **Monday 3rd November**, please note however that if enough contributions are not made it will be necessary to cancel the trip in line with the Charges and Remissions Policy.
