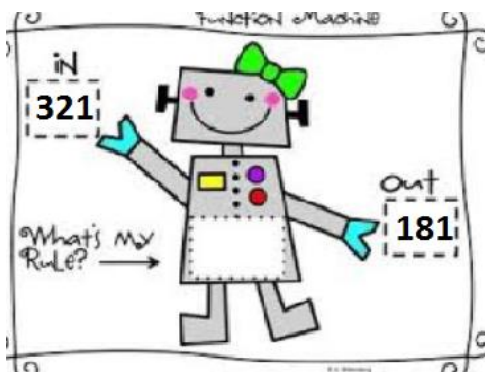

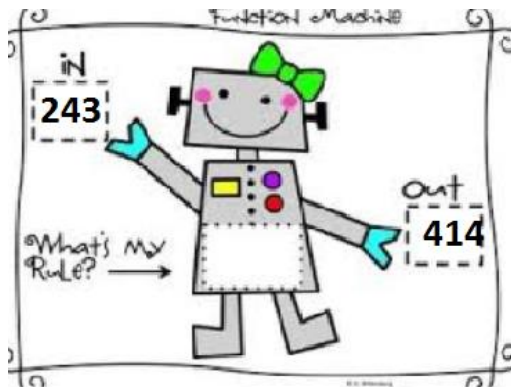
Prove it
