

Year 6 SATs 2022

- The tests will take place on the week commencing Monday 9th May 2022. These will take place throughout the whole week.
- During SATs week, children will be encouraged to be in school by 8:30 so that they can enjoy a breakfast cereal bar and juice with their friends in a calm and relaxed environment.
- As often as possible, children will complete each test in their usual classrooms.
- They will be taking: 3 maths papers (two reasoning and one arithmetic), 1 reading paper, 1 grammar and punctuation test and 1 spelling test.
- Children will be given a raw score (marks out of the total test) and will be told whether they 'meet the standard' or not.

New homework

- Children will be given a SATs pack as their homework folder.
- In their SATs pack will be: SATs information sheet, Tracker, KS2 maths revision guide, GPS test book and a list of the statutory spellings.
- Each week they **must** complete: polishing of their maths sheet (using the revision guide to help them if needed), weekly GPS test, practise their spellings and read at least 3 times a week.
- Homework will be sent home on a Friday and collected on the following Friday.
- If their homework isn't handed in/completed by each Friday, they will need to complete it in the homework detention at lunch time that day.
- If there is any confusion with their homework, encourage your child to come and see their teacher for some extra help before the day it is due in.

How can you help?

- Encourage your child to complete their weekly homework.
- Remain positive with your child about their work and attitude towards SATs,
- Help them make the links between polishing their maths tests and finding the appropriate skills/help in their maths revision books.
- Show them www.myminimaths.co.uk where they can access lots of arithmetic style questions to practise if they wish.
- Remind them that SATs are not the end of the world and that they just need to try their best!
