Equator - an imaginary line around the middle of the planet.	Hemisphere - half of the earth when divided by the equator.
Pollution - introduction of a substance into the environment that is harmful.	Development - an improvement to the standard of living for humans.
Deforestation - the purposeful clearing of forested land.	Habitat - the natural home of an animal, plant or other organism.
